Note #1: Meningococcal conjugate ACYW vaccines protect against meningococcal types A, C, Y, and W135.

Note #2: In the Northwest Territories, the Men-C-ACYW vaccine is offered only to Grade 12 students who will be attending post-secondary education outside of the NT.

Note #3: If your child or teen needs to catch up on their vaccines, is immune compromised, or has a chronic health condition, please talk to your healthcare professional about when they should receive their vaccines.
