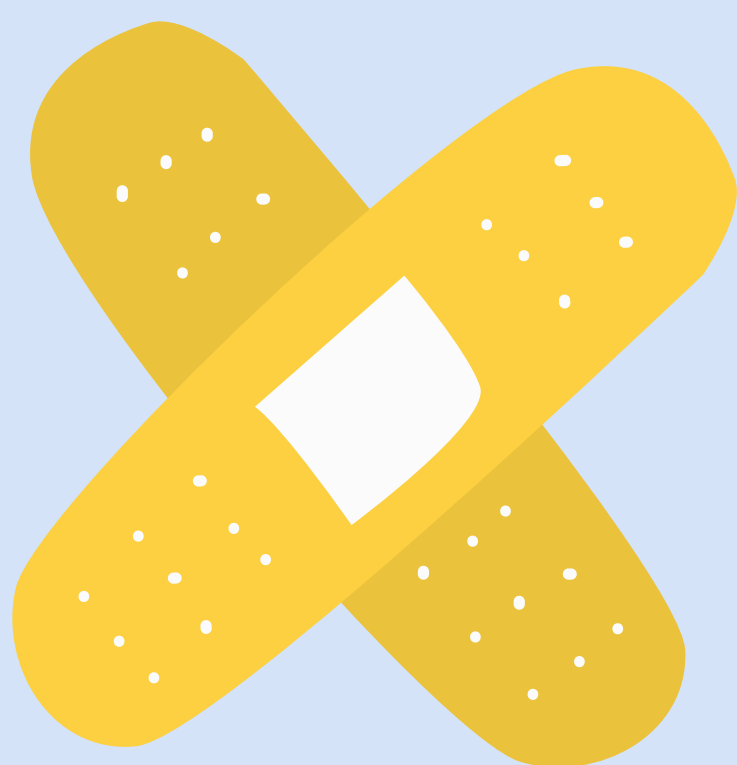


Spread the word.

**Are you protected
against meningococcal
type B (MenB)?**

Routine vaccines usually given in childhood protect against meningococcal disease types A, C, Y, and W, but not type B.

Talk to your healthcare professional about getting immunized for MenB.
