()1 Infants, children and adolescents, according to the childhood immunization schedule in their province/ territory.

**() ? Pregnant persons should be** immunized against pertussis in every pregnancy. **Immunization against** pertussis during pregnancy is safe and helps reduce the risk of the disease in infants.
